

CASSVILLE CHROMEBOOK/iPad AGREEMENT



Students at CASSVILLE in grades 4K-12 will be issued Google Chromebooks or an iPad for use in school and at home. This document provides students and their parents/guardians with information about taking care of the equipment, using it to complete assignments, and being a good digital citizen.

Students and their parents/guardians are reminded that use of TECHNOLOGY is a privilege and not a right and that everything done on any device, network, or electronic communication device may be monitored by the school authorities. Inappropriate use of the TECHNOLOGY can result in limited or banned computer use, disciplinary consequences, removal from courses, loss of credit, receiving a failing grade, and/or legal action.

OWNERSHIP of the CHROMEBOOK/iPad

CASSVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT retains sole right of possession of the Chromebook/iPad. The Chromebooks/iPads are LOANED to the students for educational purposes for the academic year. Moreover, CASSVILLE administrative staff and faculty retain the right to collect and/or inspect Chromebooks/iPads at any time, including via electronic remote access and to alter, add, delete installed software or hardware.

RESPONSIBILITY for the CHROMEBOOK/iPad

Students are solely responsible for the Chromebooks/iPads issued to them and must adhere to the following:

- must comply with the Chromebook/iPad Agreement, CASSVILLE Acceptable Use Policy, and all policies of the school when using their Chromebooks/iPad.
- must bring their Chromebooks/iPad to school every day and make sure it is fully charged. Note: A fully charged Chromebook/iPad should last 6.5 hours charged.
- must treat their device with care and never leave it in an unsecured location.
- must promptly report any problems with their Chromebook/iPad to a teacher or the office.
- may NOT remove or interfere with the serial number and other identification.
- may not attempt to remove or change the physical structure of the Chromebook/iPad, including the keys, screen cover or casing.

RESPONSIBILITY for ELECTRONIC DATA

The students are solely responsible for any apps or extensions on their Chromebook/iPad that are not installed by a member of the school staff. Students are responsible for backing up their data to protect from loss. Users of school technology have no rights, ownership, or expectations of privacy to any data that is, or was, stored on the Chromebook/iPad, school network, or any school-issued applications and are given no guarantees that data will be retained or destroyed.

Students are required to follow all copyright laws around all media including text, images, programs, music, and video. Downloading, sharing, and posting online illegally obtained media is against the Acceptable Use Policy. If a student's Chromebook/iPad is inoperable, the school has a limited number of spare devices for use while the student's Chromebook/iPad is repaired or replaced. This agreement remains in effect for loaner computers. The student may not OPT to keep an inoperable Chromebook/iPad to avoid doing class work due to loss or damage.

REPLACEMENT/REPAIR COSTS ----- Estimated Costs (subject to change)

The following are estimated costs of Chromebook parts and replacements:

- Replacement - \$300.00
- Screen - \$90.00
- Keyboard/touchpad - \$52.00
- Case- \$25

The following are estimated costs of iPad parts and replacements:

- Replacement - \$360.00
- Screen - \$100.00
- Case- \$40
